





A wood grain-patterned sheet characterized by straight grain lines and contrasting knots.



Bird's eye

A woodgrain-patterned sheet characterized by numerous speckled patterns called "bird's-eye figure."



White Carrara

A stone-patterned sheet characterized by a calm, deep pattern like that of Carrara Bianco marble.




Black Carrara

Our original stone-patterned sheet, featuring a white collar design rendered in deep black.



White Baltish

This stone-patterned sheet is characterized by its rough texture and the overlapping patterns of various stone crystals.



Black Baltish

Kraft paper

A Japanese paper-like sheet with a textured surface that creates a robust and sharp feel.



Unryu paper

A Japanese paper-like sheet with dynamic, cloud-like patterns that express the unique characteristics of washi paper.

A luxurious fabric-like seat that captures the unique texture of linen fabric.






Gradation

Molding that **protects** the texture

Our unique manufacturing method prevents damage to the texture of the design surface, which retains the texture sensation.



A design that remains continuous even when divided

Even with decorative panels that are divided into separate parts, the design remains continuous without any noticeable inconsistencies.

Supports transparency

The design of the operation icons and other elements can be displayed transparently while maintaining the high-quality design and surface texture. The transparent design is only visible when illuminated from behind, while the FESP design on the surface is normally visible.
